Activate our Dormant Workforce by restructuring the Work Bonus System

Unlike previous Campaigns advocating the illumination of Income Test entirely, 'Fair Go for Working Pensioners' is pushing to change unjust elements of the current system.

Problem

- Working Pensioners have their Pension reduced by 50 cents in every dollar earned over \$300 per fortnight (\$150 per week)
- The \$300 threshold is not indexed and has not changed since July 2019
- Centrelink's reporting to the ATO inflates the taxable income for the Working member of a couple

Solution

- Immediately increase the threshold to at least \$500
- Index the threshold
- Allow the Pension reduction to the non working member of a couple to be claimable as a deduction from the workers taxable income, retrospectively for three years.

Benefits

- If increasing and indexing is sufficient to restore pre Covid participation rates could result in:
 - An annual saving to Government of \$200,000,000 every year in reduced Pension payments, increased PAYG Tax and GST revenue
 - An additional 20,000 experienced workers re-enter the legitimate workforce easing the current skills shortage
 - Help Pensioners Help themselves
 - o Improve standard of living
 - o Enhance sense of worth and mental health
 - Continuing employment for older Australians provides financial and nonfinancial benefits for individuals and brings substantial benefit to the broader community
